

## **Our Mission**

The Ho-Ho-Kus Education Foundation is a nonprofit, 501 ©(3) charitable, tax-exempt organization managed by an Independent Board of Trustees comprised of volunteer school parents and members of the school administration. The Trustees evaluate grant requests which are sponsored by a teacher or group of teachers in support of various school-wide initiatives. The Ho-Ho-Kus Education Foundation has awarded over \$1 million in grants since its inception in 1992. Grants are allocated to programs and technologies which are deemed to enhance the educational experience of all students across all grade levels and learning abilities. To date, these grants have included the purchase of the following: SmartBoards for every grade, TV Studio, Career Technology Lab, Laptop Lab and an Outdoor Classroom in the courtyard as well as many others that would not have been funded. Most recently (June 2015), the Foundation approved grants to purchase Chromebooks for all students in grades 5-8; Desktop Replacements for grades Pre-K-8; Peaceful Playground for all grades during recess; two Author visits and workshops; Educate 2B/Zensational Kids as well as additional grants for specific grade levels.

With the unwavering and continued support of the Ho-Ho-Kus school community, the Ho-Ho-Kus Education Foundation looks forward to many more years of supporting our school and our children.
